

## How LPGA-USGA Girls Golf Memberships Work

*LPGA-USGA Girls Golf is a national organization supported by the USGA and LPGA Foundation. The local Chattanooga site is administered by the Tennessee Golf Foundation under the direction of TGF Chattanooga Regional Director, Dori Paschall.*

An annual membership (\$0 cost to you each year) is required to take part in national, regional, and local programs, activities, and events. Fees will apply to take part in most programs, activities, and events.

If you join in December, your membership rolls into the following year.

Once you have joined or renewed your membership you are then eligible to take part in national, regional, and local events and activities.

For the Chattanooga site, we offer a “grace period” for your membership. Simply meaning, that if you enrolled as a member January – November of the previous year then we’ll continue to allow you to take part in our local programs, activities, and events into the following year until April 1<sup>st</sup>. You will be kept on the chapter roster until this date. After April 1<sup>st</sup> you will need to renew your membership to be eligible for the remaining programs and events for the year.

Example:

You joined/renewed Jan – Nov 2021. Your chapter (Chattanooga) membership will be valid until April 1, 2022.

Tips for joining and renewing:

- If you are renewing, it is recommended to renew using the L-UGG app:

**Why it's important to renew.** Our local program receives grant funding for each member of our local site, usually \$25/member. If you don't renew, then a) you cannot participate, and b) we receive less grant dollars to support our local site. How much you participate each year doesn't matter. You can simply renew each year for \$0 and our local site gets \$25.
